Rob Drummond:

Rob Drummond is an award winning playwright, performer, director and theatre maker based in Glasgow, Scotland. His wide ranging work includes the critically acclaimed *Rob Drummond: WRESTLING*, which took place in a ring at the Arches (2011, Glasgow) and involved five months professional wrestling training, and a modern retelling of *The Passion*, which premiered in George Square, Glasgow in 2011. His other recent projects include *The Riot of Spring* (Tramway, Behaviour festival, May 2013, Glasgow), a response to Stravinsky's *The Rite of Spring*, where he worked with a choreographer as part of the Arches and **National Theatre of Scotland**'s *Auteurs Project*, and *Quiz Show* for the Traverse Theatre (Edinburgh). *Bullet Catch* was first performed at the Arches' *Behaviour* festival in 2009 and was a huge hit at the 2012 *Edinburgh Festival Fringe*, winning both a **Herald Angel Award** and a **Total Theatre Award**. Rob studied English at the University of Glasgow.

The Arches:

The Arches, one of Europe's leading cultural venues, is both an arts receiving and production house with an international reputation as an exciting hub of ground-breaking creativity. Housed within seven Grade A listed Victorian railway arches in Glasgow city centre, the venue presents a year-round programme of theatre, performance, dance, visual art, live music and club nights. The programming team employs calculated risk-taking in all of its creative decisions, nurturing emergent talent and rewarding bold approaches with a supportive environment for further innovation – showcased each autumn at **Arches LIVE**, a two week long celebration of new, Scottish, contemporary performance talent. Alongside local artists, the last few years have seen world-class international artists and companies such as **The TEAM**, **Derevo**, **Ann Liv Young**, **Mammalian Diving Reflex**, **Ontroerend Goed**, **Akhe**, **Taylor Mac** and **Tim Crouch** perform in the venue as part of its annual **Behaviour** festival of live performance. The Arches regularly takes work to the **Edinburgh Fringe** and has won numerous awards there, including several **Fringe Firsts**, **Herald Angels** and **Total Theatre Awards**.
